This letter is just an introduction to alert you to what to expect in the next few weeks. The first step for both classes is to set up my Google Classroom. For returning students, hopefully this will not be a problem. For students new to the format, you will be receiving an email inviting your child to join their respective classes. Each class has a code that allows access only to those invited. Therefore, the purpose of this email is to inquire how you would like to have your child enrolled in Google Classroom. Please consider the following:

If you want to be the one receiving the emails and posted materials, then the email you are viewing this on will be the one enrolled in the class.

If you want only your child to receive emails on their own personal account, you need to forward me their email address, letting me know NOT to include yours.

If you want both you AND your child to receive the notifications and posted work, then you need to send me their email address, making sure to let me know you would like to stay on the class list as well.

Please know that if you do not choose to have your email enrolled in Google Classroom, you will not be privy to any classroom communications regarding deadlines or class information.

We live in a world that allows for instant, excessive communication that challenges our ability to prioritize the salient. If at any time you would like to amend how your child is receiving their information, I can certainly amend Google Classroom to either include or remove email accounts.

I will be posting all pertinent material on Google Classroom for each class from here on out. Looking forward to getting this year underway!
